

Timeline:

- January 15: Conference Registration Deadline
- February 24th or 25th: Written Essay (conference schedule will be posted on the <u>SLC</u> <u>Info Page</u> closer to conference date)

Event Breakdown: (based off National HOSA guidelines)

- Competitor's MUST present a photo ID or proof of identity when checking in to their competitive event. A clear picture of a photo ID is acceptable. If a student does not bring a photo ID, the student's advisor may be asked to report to the event manager or HOSA Headquarters and verify the student's identity.
- Competitors will follow the Competitive Process outlined in the event guidelines (pages 1-2).
- HOSA will NOT provide a computer for competitors. Per the event guidelines, competitors are responsible for bringing a device that is battery powered, has Microsoft Word, and has a USB port.
- Please save your document at a PDF- THEN upload it onto the flashdrive. This will ensure no edit changes in the process.
- Judges will be using the rubric provided in the Extemporaneous Writing event guidelines <u>https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/21-22-EW-FINAL-Aug-20.pdf</u>
