Membership Information



Post-secondary/Collegiate (PS/C) membership looks a bit different in Michigan than Middle School and Secondary (high school) membership. Please see information below regarding PS/C membership:

1. Historically, PS/C chapters are run primarily by student members, but the PS/C chapter must still have a school-sanctioned adult to serve as the HOSA advisor. This advisor needs to sign the [HOSA Chapter Memorandum of Understanding \(MOU\)](#), but for **PS/C chapters only**, the following criteria is amended:
 - a. The advisor does NOT need to attend conferences with the PS/C members.
 - b. *One* designated student member can *also* serve at the liaison between the chapter members and Michigan HOSA (i.e. email MI HOSA staff with questions, be part of communication chains, etc.).
 - c. An administrator does not need to sign the MOU. The advisor's signature is sufficient.
 - d. The PS/C advisor does not need to be affiliated in the [HOSA Conference Management System \(CMS\)](#) as a paying member. If they decide to affiliate, then they are responsible for paying the \$20 dues.
2. PS/C members do not compete at a regional conference, instead, they compete at the annual State Leadership Conference. The top three competitors in each event at SLC are then qualified to compete at the International Leadership Conference.
 - a. **For the 2026-2027 year, PS/C members will NOT attend the state conference.** Because the state conference is unusually late this year (April 29-30, 2027) and it being finals week for most PS/C members, **Michigan HOSA will use the Region 5 Leadership Conference as the PS/C ILC Qualifier event.**
 - b. PS/C members who wish to compete, please register for the Region 5 Leadership Conference by **Saturday, December 19, 2026.**
 - c. The Region 5 Leadership Conference & PS/C ILC Qualifier will take place Saturday, January 16, 2027 at Rochester Adams High School.
3. Not all competitive events will be available for PS/C members to compete in. Please see the full list of events PS/C members can choose from here:
