Extemporaneous Health Poster- Middle School

Timeline:

- January 15: Conference Registration Deadline
- February 24th or 25th: Competition (conference schedule will be posted on the <u>SLC Info</u> <u>Page</u> closer to conference date)

Event Breakdown: (based off National HOSA guidelines)

- Competitor's MUST present a photo ID or proof of identity when checking in to their competitive event. A clear picture of a photo ID is acceptable. If a student does not bring a photo ID, the student's advisor may be asked to report to the event manager or HOSA Headquarters and verify the student's identity.
- Competitors will follow the poster competitive process outlined in the event guidelines (pages 1-2).
- HOSA will NOT provide supplies for competitors EXCEPT the white poster board. Per the event guidelines, competitors are responsible for bringing the supplies listed in guidelines.
- When students are done, they will leave their posters in the room for judges to later evaluate. If students wish to keep their posters, they can be picked up at HOSA Headquarters after the competition. Any posters not picked up by Saturday morning (Feb. 26th) will be properly disposed of.
- Judges will be using the rubric provided in the Extemporaneous Health Poster event guidelines https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/21-22-EHP-FINAL-Aug-22.pdf

Dress Code:

As Future Health Professionals, HOSA members should present themselves in a professional manner. Competitors shall wear official HOSA uniform or proper business attire for judge presentations. Bonus points will NOT be awarded, but event managers will make note if competitors are NOT in proper dress which could result in overall point deduction.
