Conference attendees must register for the conference through their school using the HOSA Conference Management System, the same way they registered for regionals. When registering, please make sure you include each student's T-shirt size and advisor pullover size.

NOTE: The only people that need to register for the conference and pay the \$75 registration fee are students, advisors and anyone else who wants the conference materials provided; conference program, name badge, and admittance to general sessions (including award ceremonies). If a guest/family member/chaperone plans to attend but does NOT want/need any of those things (including a seat at ceremonies), then they do not need to register and pay for the conference.
