



Michigan HOSA Officer Candidate Procedure

Round One

Complete and submit the online [Michigan HOSA Officer Candidate Application](#).

A selected committee will review your application. The committee will determine your eligibility to run for State HOSA Office at the 2022 HOSA State Leadership Conference February 24-25, 2022 at the Grand Traverse Resort & Spa.

You will receive a letter by email confirming that your application has been reviewed and if you have or have not been selected to run as a candidate for State HOSA Office.

Round Two

If you are selected as an Officer Candidate, you are required to complete the following tasks at the 2022 HOSA State Leadership Conference:

- Complete a written test evaluating your knowledge of HOSA
- Answer an impromptu question on stage during the first general session
- Interview with the current HOSA State Officers
- Give a five-minute speech before the HOSA Voting Delegates

Round Three

Candidates acquiring the most combined points in each section (interview, impromptu question, written test, and speech) will be voted into the 2022-2023 HOSA State Office.

Elected Officers are slated into positions according to their choice selected in the Michigan HOSA Officer Candidate Application.

The elected officer with the most points will have his/her first choice of officer position. For example if 'Joe Schmoe' acquired the most amount of points and desired to be State Secretary, he would be slated into the Secretary position. The elected officer with the second highest amount of points will then have his/her choice of office as long as it hasn't been previously chosen.

Elected candidates are installed as officers during the Second General Session.
