Who is eligible for Recognition Events?

- 2. Any member who wants to participate virtually. Recognition events are the only virtual option for competitors. Participants can do more than one Recognition event.

- All tests are open book/open note. This does not mean taking tests with classmates. These tests are meant to test your INDIVIDUAL knowledge on the subject. Proctors are not required for testing.
- Tests can be taken on a smartphone, tablet or computer. Please ensure you have a stable internet connection to reduce online testing issues.
- Competitors can only take the test between the times listed in the schedule. After posted times, the online test will be closed.
- Competitors CANNOT login to the online test until the exact time listed in the schedule. For example, if the test is from 9:00am-11:00am, you will not be able to login until 9:00am. If you login at 8:59am or before, the system will not let you take the test.
- It does not matter when you start your test in the time listed in the schedule, as long as you start the test within the two hours listed. For example, if the test is from 9:00am-11:00am, you can login at 10:59am and will still be given the full amount of time for the test.
- If you have any issues logging in, accessing online testing, or if you did not receive password and login information, please call (517) 347-8088 or (517) 677-7480 immediately.

Pro Tip:

Competitors should make sure they have their testing login credentials prior to their testing date and time.

Login credentials are case sensitive. Please make sure you are typing in the username and passwords correctly. Again, you can only login during the testing window! For example, if your test is from 10am-noon and you try to login at 9:59am or sooner, THE SYSTEM WILL NOT LET YOU. Therefore, do not try and "practice" logging in prior to the testing time because it will not work.
