Who is eligible for Recognition Events?

- **1.** Any member attending the in-person conference can compete in a Recognition Event along with their competitive event.
- 2. Any member who wants to participate virtually. <u>Recognition events are the only</u> <u>virtual option for competitors.</u> Participants can do more than one Recognition event.

What is a Recognition Event?

These events are not a competitive event, but a way to recognize HOSA members for their efforts. These events are not qualifiers for the International Leadership Conference. The specific events available for Michigan HOSA students for the 2024 State Leadership Conference are listed below.

- Competitors must submit electronically via the HOSA Digital Upload System, by March 23rd, 11:59pm.
- Submissions that earn 80 points or higher will be recognized online and at awards ceremony on April 18.
- All submissions earning a score of 80 points or higher at the chartered association level will be eligible for recognition at the HOSA International Leadership Conference. The names of those chapters who earn 80 points or higher will be submitted by Michigan HOSA event personnel.

 - These will be an online test using the <u>HOSA Online Testing System</u> for ALL competitors.

General Online Testing Instructions

- Online tests will be taken using the <u>HOSA testing system</u>.
- Login credentials will be emailed to you and your HOSA advisor the week of March 18.
- All tests are open book/open note. This does not mean taking tests with classmates. These tests are meant to test your INDIVIDUAL knowledge on the subject. Proctors are <u>not</u> required for testing.
- Tests can be taken on a smartphone, tablet or computer. Please ensure you have a stable internet connection to reduce online testing issues.
- Competitors can only take the test between the times listed in the schedule. After posted times, the online test will be closed.
- Competitors CANNOT login to the online test until the exact time listed in the schedule. For example, if the test opens at 9:00AM, you will not be able to login until 9:00 AM. If you login at 8:59 AM or before, the system will not let you take the test.
- It does not matter when you start your test in the time listed in the schedule, as long as you start the test within the two hours listed. For example, if the test is open from 9:00 AM-5:00 PM, you can login at 4:59 PM and will still be given the full amount of time for the test.

Pro Tip:

Competitors should make sure they have their testing login credentials prior to their testing date and time.

Login credentials are case sensitive. Please make sure you are typing in the username and passwords correctly. Again, you can only login during the testing window! Do not try and "practice" logging in prior to the testing time because it will not work.
