Congratulations on qualifying for the Michigan HOSA State Leadership Conference!

Timeline:

- January 15: Conference Registration Deadline
- February 24th or 25th: Test and Round Two (conference schedule will be posted on the <u>SLC Info Page</u> closer to conference date)

Event Breakdown: (based off National HOSA guidelines)

- Competitor's MUST present a photo ID or proof of identity when checking in to their competitive event. A clear picture of a photo ID is acceptable. If a student does not bring a photo ID, the student's advisor may be asked to report to the event manager or HOSA Headquarters and verify the student's identity.
- There is NO TALLO upload requirement for this event at the state level.
- All teams will take the Round One written test at the conference. This is NOT an online test and is NOT an open note/book test. Please check the schedule/conference program for when and where your test is.
- The Round One test will be used as a qualifier for Round Two. The teams advancing to Round Two will be seeded according to their scores in Round One. The Round Two bracket will be posted online at www.michiganhosa.org/slc. If you are unsure, please check with HOSA Headquarters.
- For Round Two, please report to the room at the time listed online. Event manager(s) will check competitors in.
- Teams will follow the Round Two- Debate Round process listed in the event guidelines (pages 3-4).
- Please do not shake judges hands to help prevent the spread of germs.
- Because this is a team event, competitors MUST compete in-person with the maximum/minimum number of members listed in the guidelines. No more, no less.
- Judges are instructed NOT to talk to students after presentations. Competitor rubrics are
 confidential and will not be shared with students after competition. Any feedback judges
 wish to give students will be written on a "Judge Feedback Card" and given to the HOSA
 advisor following the Grand Awards Ceremony on Friday the 25th.
- Absolutely NO spectators are not allowed to watch presentations. The only authorized personnel in the competitive event room are judges, event manager(s), HOSA staff and the competitor/team.
