What is the HOSA Challenge?

The Gift of Life HOSA Challenge is a 4-week service project for Michigan HOSA chapters that saves lives. During the HOSA Challenge, students recruit their peers and community members to join the Michigan Organ Donor Registry while completing activities to educate them about the importance of organ and tissue donation.

How does it work?

1. Learn more and sign your chapter up to participate at golm.org/hosa or sign up using the QR code above.
2. Register to attend the HOSA Challenge Kickoff Meeting on **Sept. 24 at 7 p.m.** The Kickoff will cover changes to the program this year, donation basics and how to sign people up on the Michigan Organ Donor Registry. A link will be sent to those who register their school to participate. Attend this meeting and get 50 points!
3. Keep an eye out for your free Challenge Toolkit with your Donor Registry link, materials and giveaways. Toolkits will be mailed as registrations are received.
4. From Oct. 6 to Oct. 31, complete activities listed on the scorecard and log them at golm.org/hosa to earn points.
5. Redeem your points for Visa gift cards.
